Think your pies are the best in Kamloops? The B.C. Wildlife Park is challenging all amateur bakers in the region to compete for the Best Pie Baker in Kamloops title in our Pie Baking Contest on October 8th! This is a fundraiser to help us purchase new materials for our education programs, which will help us teach over 6,500 students this school year!

How will the pies be judged?

Our guest judges will judge the pies based on appearance, taste, and authenticity. Pies and fillings must be made from scratch and can have any fruit filling. No dairy based filling or meringue pies. We encourage all participants to use locally grown products in their pie!

**pies that require refrigeration will not be accepted due to food safety reasons.*

Prizes!

Prizes will be awarded for first, second, and third place:



GRAND PRIZE: Stay and golf package at the South Thompson Inn
(valued at \$419)

Includes: One night stay in a Deluxe King Room, dinner for two at madisens restaurant, and one 18 hole round of golf at Rivershore Golf Links.

Second place: Family Annual Pass to the BC Wildlife Park

How do I enter?

There is an entry contribution of \$10. We ask that you bring two pies, one for judging, and one to be auctioned off to help us raise money for new materials for our education programs!

Registration forms must be filled out and submitted with the \$10 entry contribution by October 1st. Pies must be dropped off on October 6th or 7th at the BC Wildlife Park. Please label the pies with your name, type of pie, as well as which pie you would like to be judged. Please use disposable pie plates as you may not get the plates back!

Pies will be judged on October 8th at 10:00 am. Winners will be announced at 11:00 am. The silent auction for the pies will be open from 11:00 am-3:30pm.

**please note that you do not have to be in attendance to win*

We would appreciate a copy of your recipe. This recipe, credited with the name of the baker, may be sold in a recipe booklet to help us meet our fundraising goals.
